HINSDALE TOPS HIGH SCHOOL ALL AMERICAN

Detroit, Mich. — The 1969-1970 high school swimming season has subsided, but the memory of one of the finest interscholastic seasons ever was refreshed as the All American selections were released by Ralph Deetz, Chairman, National Interscholastic Coaches Swimming Association, selection committee.

High school swimmers set one national record and three short course high school marks in their bid for All American award recognition.

The greatest assemblage of high school swimming talent in the last 10 years comprises this year's All American Team selections by the N.I.S.C.A.

Throughout the United States, swimming has increased so fast that only 10 states did not participate in competitive swimming in the 1969-1970 season. With this growth, records will continue to fall and the United States will continue its supremacy in swimming.

Over 200 schools were honored this year with All American selections. Four states received their first All American awards: North Dakota, Kentucky, Utah, and Tennessee.

The team power has shifted from Santa Clara, California, High School, to Hinsdale Central, Illinois, High School. Team balance was so competitive this year that only three selections separated the top three teams: Hinsdale Central with 16; Wilson, Washington, High School, with 14; and Santa Clara with 13. Following them was Upper Arlington, Ohio, High School, with eight; and Serra, California, High School, and Westfield, New Jersey, High School, both with six All Americans.

Led by such outstanding All American swimmers as Mark Lambert and John Kinsella of Hinsdale Central; Mike Stamm of Crawford High School, California; Tom Bruce of Peterson High School, California; Doug Windes and Ed McCleskey, Santa Clara; John Trembly of Shaker High School, New York, the only double first place All American; Keith Gilliam, of Rock Island High School, Illinois; and Kurt Knipfer of Wilson; the high school swimmers have established even lower qualifications for All American selection next year.

The assault on the records this season produced three short course records. John Trembly of Shaker, set a 50 yard freestyle mark of 20.7, clipping five tenths off the old mark. Mike Stamm of Crawford, notched a 100 yard backstroke record of 51.9 (setting an American record at the A.A.U. Nationals of 51.3), which chopped 1.2 off the old mark. John Kinsella of Hinsdale Central, broke the 400 yard freestyle standard with 3:31.5, to lop 6.5 off the old record.

The top All Americans in the other events are: 100 yard freestyle Martin Pedley, Gunn High School, California, 46.5; 200 yard freestyle Tom McBreen, Serra, 1:41.2; 100 yard breaststroke Tom Bruce, Peterson, 58.7; 100 yard butterfly John Trembly, Shaker, 50.5; 200 yard individual medley Steve Furniss, Foothill High School, California, 1:57.2; 200 yard medley relay Upper Arlington with Jeff Lewis, Steve Miely, Bryon Snow, and Tom McElroy, 1:37.9; and 400 yard freestyle relay Hinsdale Central with Mark Lambert, Phil Dodson, Gary Ferraro, and John Kinsella, 3:09.9.

The automatic All American selection times for next season are: Medley relay 1:41.2; 200 free 1:44.3; 200 IM 1:58.5; 50 free 21.7; 100 fly 52.3; 100 free 47.5; 100 back 54.4; 400 free 3:44.7; 100 breast 1:01.8; 400 free relay 3:17.6.

INDIANA NABS 34 SPOTS AS HALL, HENRY, SPITZ, BARBIERE, TOP NCAA ALL AMERICANS

Salt Lake City, Utah — Ten swimmers gained the top 15 individual positions as Indiana, the collegiate champs, grabbed 34 top NCAA All American spots, announced Don B. Reddish, Chairman, All American Selection Committee.

Indiana was led by Jim Henry, who repeated his top rankings in the one and three meter springboard. Also taking NCAA titles and being the number one All American in their events were freshmen Larry Barbieri in the 100 backstroke and Gary Hall in the 400 IM, and sophomore Mark Spitz in the 100 butterfly for Indiana.

Indiana out did themselves with 34 All American rankings, one more than last year, followed by USC with 22 and UCLA with 19. Stanford and Cal State Long Beach tied at 14 All Americans, while Michigan had 12, SMU 11, Michigan State and Washington 9, Colorado State University 7, and Florida and Tennessee 6. Yale, who did not compete at the NCAA's due to their early season ban, placed five All Americans, as did Dartmouth.

Thirty-five schools were represented on the 1970 All American, four less than 1969.

UCLA had three first place rankings all due to senior Mike Burton, who turned in a fabulous triple at the NCAA championships winning the 500 and 1650 freestyle and 200 butterfly.

Brian Job of Stanford and Dave Edgar of Tennessee were both double first place winners at the NCAA. Job leads the All American selection in the 100 and 200 breaststrokes, and Edgar was the fastest 50 and 100 freestyler.

Indiana placed four divers on the All American, as Princeton, and Michigan State followed with three each.

Gary Hall lead all of the All American selections, placing in five events. The Hoosier freshman was named All American in the 500 and 1650 freestyle, 200 and 400 IM and 200 back. Spitz, Bello and Doug Russell, Univ. Texas at Arlington, Jerry Heidenrich, SMU, gained recognition in four events each.

The only two individuals to repeat their top rankings from the 1969 NCAA All American were Spitz in the 100 fly and Henry in both the one and three meter boards. Three freshman nabbed a top ranking, as Barbieri, Hall and Job took the best spots. Six events went to graduating seniors, with Juan Bello of Michigan taking the 200 free, Henry in the diving events and Burton in the freestyles and butterfly.

All winners at the NCCA championship at University of Utah were automatically selected to the first spot on the 1970 All American list.

Pottstown, Pa.—Fred Tyler, a junior from St. Andrew's School in Florida, made Prep All American in every event, leading the way with Prep Records in the 200 individual medley and 400 freestyle on the 1970 National Interscholastic Coaches Association Prep All American, as compiled by Alan A. Switzer, Jr., Chairman of the All American Committee.

Tyler led the 200 IM with a prep record of 1:56.6 with Pine Crest's Kendall Prigg, the runner up with 1:58.4, followed by Tim McKee, Malvern, 1:59.5; and the 400 free with a prep record of 3:42.6 to top Chris Noll, Pine Crest, 3:47.6, and Tommy Platt, Bolles School, 3:51.7.

Fred also made All American in the 50 free, 22.4 (8th), 100 free, 48.9 (3rd), 200 free, 1:45.8 (2nd), 100 butterfly, 53.8 (3rd), 100 backstroke, 56.4 (7th), and 100 breaststroke, 1:04.5 (5th).

Noll topped Tyler in the 200 free with a prep record of 1:43.7, and was also second in the 100 free behind Chip Harrison, Newark Academy, 47.7 to 48.3. Harrison was second in the 50 free sprint behind Andrew Brown of Williston Academy, 21.5 to 21.6, which ties the prep national record.

Prigg topped the prep backstrokers with a national mark of 53.3 over McKee, 53.8, and Scott McAdams, Milton Hershey, 55.0.

Andy Lehner, Pine Crest, led the 100 butterfly with 52.0 to lead teammate Bill Wild, 52.9, while Randy Midkiff of the Bolles School, led all prep breaststrokers with 1:02.0 over Williston's Larry Bushey, 1:03.5.

Mike deGruy, Sewanee Military Academy, topped the prep diving list for the third year in a row, as did Westminster's Billy Heinz. Others making All American in diving were: John Lilley, Newark Academy, David Nielson, Pine Crest, Steve Schenthal, Metairie Park Country Day, (1969 repeat), and Tom Trapp, Bellarmine Prep.

Pine Crest, which dominated the listing, tied for first in the 200 yd. medley relay with Williston Academy at 1:39.5 (Prep mark), ahead of the Bolles School, 1:41.3, and topped Williston in the 400 yd. free relay 3:15.3 to 3:17.6 with Lawrenceville School, third, 3:18.7.

Proposals can only be submitted by District AAU Association Swimming Committees, or by individual members of the National AAU Men's or Women's Swimming Committees. If you are not a national committee member you must go through your local swimming committee (not your Registration Committee or Board of Managers). Please do not do as one of our friends did (a non-committeeman) who quite properly sent a long list of proposed rule changes to his local swimming
