

PIAA COACH'S SIGNATURE CARD

In dual meets, Rule 3, page 15 of the 2011-2012 NFHS Swimming and Diving Rule Book states: a competitor officially becomes a participant in all events when the official entry card or diving scoresheet bearing the name of the event, that competitor's first and last name, coach's signature (where applicable), name of school and lane assignment is submitted to the referee or referee's designee. At the NFHS Swimming and Diving Rules Interpretation Meeting in Indianapolis (2008), the question was asked about signatures on entry cards. The answer was that entry cards must be signed. This rule will now be met by the use of the PIAA Coach's Signature card. This signature card will be signed by both coaches at the Coaches and Captains Meeting and no other coaches signatures will be required on any other documents/entry cards, etc. submitted during a meet. This card will be kept by the referee for 48 hours following the completion of the meet.
